

166. The Andhra Pradesh Police (Computer Centre) Subordinate Service Rules

*[G.O.Ms.No. 222, Home (Police-C) Dated 29-3-1994,
published in A.P. Gazette, Part I-Ext., Dt. 7-4-94]*

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India and of all other powers hereunto enabling and supersession of the all rules, the Governor of Andhra Pradesh, hereby makes the following Special Rules for the Andhra Pradesh Police (Computer Centre) Subordinate Service.

Rule 1. Short Title :—These rules may be called the Andhra Pradesh Police (Computer Centre) Subordinate Service Rules.

Rule 2. Constitution :—This Service shall consist of the following categories of posts.

Class A :

Category (1) : Associate Programmer.

Category (2) : Punch Operator.

Class B :

S.I. of Police or equivalent.

Rule 3. Method of appointment and appointing authority :—Subject to the other provisions in these rules, the method of appointing authority for several categories shall be as follows :

*Note :—*The post of Punch Operator will be governed by the *Adhoc* Rules issued in G.O.Ms.No. 783, Home (Police-C) Department, dated 21st December, 1981.

Rule 4. Tenure :—The appointment on tenure basis to the any post in this service shall not ordinarily be for more than three years at a time subject to extension for a maximum period of five years :

Provided that nothing in these Rules shall preclude the Government or the Director General and Inspector General of Police, as the case may be to repatriate the Officers taken on tenure basis to their respective parent Department before expiry of the period of tenure, if it is considered necessary in the public interest.

Rule 5. Qualifications :—No person shall be eligible for appointment to the categories specified in Column (1) of the Annexure to these Rules by the method specified in Column (2) unless he possesses the qualifications specified in the corresponding entry in Column (3) thereof.

Rule 6. Reservation of appointment :—The Rule of Special Representation (General Rules 22 & 23-A) shall apply to appointments made by direct recruitment to the post of Associate Programmer, provided that no reservation shall be made for physically handicapped persons.

Rule 7. Age :—No person shall be eligible for appointment by direct recruitment to any posts in this service, if he has completed the age of 28 years on the first day of July of the year in which the notification for selection is made.

Rule 8. Minimum service :—No person shall be eligible for appointment by transfer unless he is an approved probationer and has put in not less than three years of service in the category from which promotion is made.

Rule 9. Probation :—(a) Every person appointed by direct recruitment to the post of Associate Programmer shall, from the date on which he commences probation, be on probation for a total period of two years on duty within a continuous period of three years.

(b) Every person appointed to any of the post by transfer shall, from the date on which he commences probation, be on probation for a total period of one year on duty within continuous period of two years.

Rule 10. Training :—(a) Every person appointed by direct recruitment to the post of Associate Programmer, shall undergo, immediately after appointment, a course of training for a period of one year as per such programme and syllabus as may be prescribed by the Director, Police Computer Services within the period of probation.

(b) Every person appointed by transfer to the post of Associate Programmer shall undergo immediately after appointment a course of training for a period of three months as per such programme and syllabus as may be prescribed by the Director, Police Computer Services, within the period of probation.

(c) Every person appointed to the service by direct recruitment shall, before the commencement of training, execute an agreement bond that he shall serve the department for a period of three years after the completion of training referred to in sub-rule (a).

He is liable to repay to the Government the pay and allowances or any other remuneration received by him in addition to the amount spent by the Government on his training, if—

(i) he fails to serve the department for period of three years after the completion of his training for any reason; or

(ii) he discontinues the training or is discharged from training course for misconduct or any other reasons; or

(iii) he secures any other employment elsewhere than under the State Government. However, the instructions issued in G.O.Ms.No. 268, Finance Department, dt. 8-9-1980 will be applicable in such cases.

(d) The period of training shall count for purposes of probation, increments, leave and pension.

(e) A direct recruit shall be eligible, during the period of training, for the initial pay of the posts with usual allowances admissible at the place of training.

Rule 11. Tests :—Every person appointed by direct recruitment to the post of Associate Programmer shall pass the Accounts Test for Subordinate Officers, Part I within the period of probation.
