

167. The Andhra Pradesh Police (Finger Print Bureau) Service Rules

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India and of all other powers hereunto enabling, the Governor of Andhra Pradesh and in supersession of the Special Rules issued in G.O. Ms. No. 335, General Administration (Rules) Department; dt. 4-3-1959 as amended from time to time, hereby makes the following Special Rules for the Andhra Pradesh Police (Finger Print Bureau) Service.

Rule 1. Short title :—These rules may be called the Andhra Pradesh Police (Finger Print Bureau) Service Rules.

Rule 2. Constitution :—The Service shall consist of the following categories of posts in the Andhra Pradesh Police (Finger Print Bureau) Service:

Category (1) : Director (Finger Print Bureau)

Category (2) : Deputy Superintendent of Police (Finger Print Bureau).

Rule 3. Method of appointment :—Subject to the other provisions in these rules, the method of appointment for the several categories of posts shall be as follows :

Category 1. Director (Finger Print Bureau) :—(i) By promotion from Category 2 i.e., Deputy Superintendent of Police (Finger Print Bureau)

(ii) If no qualified Deputy Superintendent of Police (Finger Print Bureau) is available or if qualified Deputy Superintendent of Police (Finger Print Bureau) is not suitable for promotion, by transfer on tenure of an Additional Superintendent of Police.

Category 2. Deputy Superintendent of Police (Finger Print Bureau) :—By appointment by transfer of Inspector of Police (Finger Print Bureau).

Rule 4. Minimum service :—No Inspector of Police (Finger Print Bureau) shall be eligible for appointment by transfer as Deputy Superintendent of Police (Finger Print Bureau) unless he has put in not less than six years of service in the category of Inspector (Finger Print Bureau) and no Deputy Superintendent (Finger Print Bureau) shall be eligible for promotion as Director, Finger Print Bureau, unless he has put in not less than five years of service in the category of Deputy Superintendent of Police (Finger Print Bureau) as on 1st day of the January of the year, in which the selection is made.

Rule 5. Probation :—Every person appointed to any of the aforementioned post either by promotion or by transfer shall, from the date on which he commences probation, be on probation for a total period of one year on duty within a continuous period of two years.
