

173. Andhra Pradesh Police (Legal, Medical and Miscellaneous) Subordinate Service Rules

In exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 8 and 10 of the Andhra Pradesh (Andhra Area) District Police Act, 1859 (Act XXIV of 1859), Section 6 of the Andhra Pradesh (Telangana Area) District Police Act, 1329 F (Andhra Pradesh Act X of 1329 F) and Section 7 of the Hyderabad City Police Act, 1348 F (Hyderabad Act IX of 1348 F) read with the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India and of all other powers hereunto enabling, the Governor of Andhra Pradesh hereby makes the following Special Rules for the Andhra Pradesh Police (Legal, Medical and Miscellaneous) Subordinate Service.

Rule 1. Short title :—These rules may be called the Andhra Pradesh Police (Legal, Medical and Miscellaneous) Subordinate Service Rules.

Rule 2. Constitution :—The Service shall consist of the following categories of posts in the Andhra Pradesh Police (Legal, Medical and Miscellaneous) Subordinate Service :

Class A :

- Category (1) : Radiographer
- Category (2) : Technician
- Category (3) : Pharmacist
- Category (4) : Maternity Assistant
- Category (5) : Mid Wife
- Category (6) : Nursing Orderly

Class B :

Assistant Law Instructor

Class C :Category (1) : **Plan Drawing Instructor (PTC)**Category (2) : **Engine Driver (PTC)**Category (3) : **Librarian****Class D :**Category (1) : **Dhobi**Category (2) : **Barber**Category (3) : **Cobbler**Category (4) : **Syee**

Rule 3. Method of appointment and appointing authority :—Subject to the other provisions in these rules the method of appointment and appointing authority for the several categories shall be as follows :

Rule 4. Period of tenure :—The appointment on tenure to any post in the service shall not ordinarily be for more than 3 years at a time.

Provided further that nothing in this rule shall preclude the Government or the Director General and Inspector General of Police from repatriating the persons taken on tenure to their parent Department before expiry of the period of tenure, if it is considered necessary to do so in public interest.

Rule 5. Qualifications :—No person shall be eligible for appointment to the categories specified in column (1) of the Annexure to these rules by the method specified in column (2) unless he possesses the qualifications specified in the corresponding entry in column (3) thereof.

Rule 6. Age :—No person shall be eligible for appointment by direct recruitment, if he has completed 28 years of age on the first day of July of the year in which the notification for selection is made.

Rule 7. Probation :—Every person appointed by direct recruitment to the post of Engine Driver shall be on probation for a total period of two years on duty within a continuous period of three years and every person appointed to any of the posts either by promotion or by transfer shall be on probation for a total period of one year on duty within a continuous period of two years, from the date on which one commences probation.

Engine Driver (PTC)	By direct recruitment	Must possess Certificate of competency for driving engines and knowledge of general mechanism of all types of engines and practical experience for a period of not less than six months ; or Must possess practical experience as an Engine Driver and in working of oil engines and pumps for a period of not less than 3 years.

Librarian	By direct recruitment	Must possess a Bachelor Degree in Arts, Science or Commerce with a Bachelor's Degree in Library Science of a University in India established or incorporated by or under a Central or a State or a Provincial Act or an Institution recognised by the University Grants Commission or an equivalent qualification.
Class D :		
1. Dhobi	By direct recruitment	Must be able to read and write Telugu language with 3 years experience as Dhobi.
2. Barber	By direct recruitment	Must be able to read and write Telugu language with 3 years experience as Barber.
3. Cobbler	By direct recruitment	Must be able to read and write Telugu language with 3 years experience as Cobbler
4. Syce	By direct recruitment	Must be able to read and write Telugu language with 3 years experience in the relevant field.
