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The Andhra Pradesh Public Health and Municipal Engineering Service Rules, 1965

[G.O.Ms.No. 168, Municipal Administration, dated 20-2-1965]

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India and in supersession of the Andhra Engineering Service, Branch 3; Sanitary and Public Health Recruitment Rules published with G.O.Ms.No. 640, H. Dt, the 9th April, 1956 at pages 875-877 of Part I of the Andhra Gaz., dt.26th April, 1956 and the Andhra Municipal Engineering Service Special Rules, published with G.O.Ms.No. 1314, L.A., the 25th September, 1956, at pages 2297-2299 of Part I of the Andhra Gaz., dated the 18th October, 1956, the Governor of Andhra Pradesh hereby makes the following rules.

Rules

1. Short title and commencement:— (1) These rules may be called the Andhra Pradesh Public Health and Municipal Engineering Service Rules 1965.

(2) They shall be deemed to have come into force on 2nd December 1960.

2. Constitution:— The Andhra Pradesh Public Health and Municipal Engineering Service shall consist of the following categories of Officers, namely:-

Category 1	: Superintending Engineers.
Category 2	: Executive Engineers
1[Category 2-A	: Executive Engineer (Electrical)
Category 2-B	: Executive Engineer (Mechanical)"
Category 3	: Executive Engineers
2[Category 3-A	: Deputy Executive Engineers (Electrical)
Category 3-B	: Deputy Executive Engineers (Mechanical/ Automobile).
Category 4	: Superintendent and Chemist, Drainage Disposal Works.
Category 5	: Asst. Executive Engineers.
Category 5(a)	: Junior Engineers (Electrical)

Explanation:— The Junior Engineers (Electrical) are not transferable to Municipalities. (G.O.Ms.No. 737 Hou. M.A. and U.D. dt. 13-9-1982.)

Explanation I:— The Executive Engineers posted to First Grade, Special Grade and Selection Grade Municipalities shall be designated as Municipal Engineers, Grade I and the Executive Engineers posted to the Municipal Corporation, Hyderabad and to the Office of the Chief Engineers in-charge of this service shall be designated as City Engineer and Deputy Chief Engineer (Public Health) respectively. The Deputy Executive Engineers posted to first grade and second grade Municipalities shall be designated as Municipal Engineers Grade II.

Explanation II:— The Asst. Executive Engineer posted to II & III Grade Municipalities shall be designated as Gazetted Municipal Engineer III Grade.

Provided also that the liability to serve in the Armed Forces will be limited to the first ten years of serving and shall not ordinarily apply to Graduate Engineers above 40 years of age.

4. Special representation:—The rules of special representation of appointments (General Rule 22) shall apply to all appointments by direct recruitment to the posts of Deputy Executive Engineers and Asst. Executive Engineers.

Provided that the rule of special representation shall not apply to the recruitment of Army Engineers against the reserved vacancies to Military Engineers.

5. Promotion:—(1) All promotions in the service shall be made on grounds of merit and ability, seniority being considered only where merit and ability are approximately equal:

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Provided that a Dy. Executive Engineer or a Municipal Engineer Grade II shall not be eligible for promotion to the post of Executive Engineer unless he has rendered service as Dy. Executive Engineer or Municipal Engineer, Grade II for not less than five years (including the period of training if recruited direct, and for not less than five years if recruited by transfer from the Andhra Pradesh Public Health and Municipal Engineering Subordinate Service).

(2) So far as qualified and suitable candidates are available the vacancies in the cadre of Dy. Executive Engineers to be filled or reserved to be filled by promotion from Asst. Executive Engineers and by transfer from Supervisors of Public Health and Municipal Engineering Subordinate Service holding Upper Subordinate Diploma of College of Engineering, Guindy or L.C.E. Diploma or an equivalent qualification or Upper Subordinate Diploma of Osmania University with 20 years of practical experience or L.S. Diploma or an equivalent qualification or Upper Subordinate Diploma of College of Engineering, Guindy or its equivalent

examination] with twenty years of practical experience shall be in the proportion of 2 : 1 and the proportion among the Upper Subordinates and the Lower Subordinates to be so appointed, shall also be 2 : 1.

Provided that if qualified and suitable candidates are not available from among the Addl. Assistant Engineers and Draughtsmen the vacancy shall be filled from the next available category among the Addl. Assistant Engineers or Draughtsmen in the cycle, from which the candidates are actually available, but not from Assistant Executive Engineers.

- (3) The vacancies in the cadre of Deputy Executive Engineers to be filled by transfer against the third vacancy of the cycle prescribed in Rule 3 from Draughtsmen shall be filled in the ratio of 1 : 1 between localised cadre of Draughtsmen of the concerned Zone and the Draughtsmen in the Office of the Chief Engineer (Public Health).

Provided that if qualified and suitable candidates are not available in the concerned zone, the vacancy shall be filled by transfer from the Draughtsmen of the Chief Engineer's Office and *vice versa*, and provided also that the distribution of vacancies is equitable having regard to the number of posts of Draughtsman in the circle offices and the Chief Engineer's Office.

6. Qualifications:- No person shall be eligible for appointment to any category in the service mentioned in column (1) and by the method mentioned in column (2) of the Table below, unless he possesses the qualifications mentioned in the corresponding entries in column (3) thereof.

7. Probation:- Every person appointed to a category in the service by direct recruitment shall be one probation for a total period of two years on duty within a continuous period of three years. In the case of a person appointed by promotion or transfer, the period of probation shall be one year on duty within a continuous period of two years.

Provided that a probationary Executive Engineer shall be entitled to count towards probation any service rendered by him as Deputy Chief Engineer, Executive Engineer (Public Health) or Municipal Engineer Grade I of the former Andhra Pradesh Municipal Engineering Service or as Executive Engineer of the former Hyderabad Local Government Service or any other foreign service to which the Executive Engineer of this service is lent before or after the issue of these rules.

Provided further that a probationary Deputy Executive Engineer shall be entitled to count towards his probation any service rendered by him before the issue of these rules as Deputy Executive Engineer (Public Health) or Municipal Engineer Grade II of the former Andhra Municipal Engineering Service or Deputy Executive Engineer in the former Hyderabad Local Government service or any other service to which the services of the Deputy Executive Engineer of this Service are lent.

Provided also, that a probationary Assistant Executive Engineer shall be entitled to count towards his probation any service rendered by him as Municipal Engineer III Grade or Assistant Executive Engineer in the Andhra Pradesh Public Health and Municipal Engineering Subordinate Service or any other service to which the services of the Assistant Executive Engineers of this service are lent.

8. Posting and Transfers:— The Chief Engineer in-charge of the Public Health and Municipal Engineering Service shall be competent to transfer Deputy Executive Engineers ¹[and Dy. Executive Engineer (Mechanical) and Assistant Executive Engineers and he shall be the appointing authority in respect of Assistant Executive Engineers from out of the personnel selected by the Andhra Pradesh Public Service Commission.

9. Practical Training:—Members of the service may be deputed for training in Sanitary Engineering for such period and on such terms as may be determined by the Government.

10. Tests:— (1) The Account Test for Public Works Department Officers and Subordinates is prescribed for Deputy Executive Engineers and Superintendents and Chemist, Drainage Disposal works and Assistant Executive Engineers recruited direct or by transfer. The test should be passed within a period of four years from appointment by direct recruitment and within the period of probation by those appointed by transfer.

(2) The penalty for failure to pass the test within the prescribed period shall be stoppage of increments until the test is passed, but the stoppage of increment shall not operate to postpone future increments after the tests have been passed:

Provided that such of Engineers as are belonging to erstwhile Hyderabad Local Government Service and have been allocated to the Andhra Pradesh State, who have not passed the Departmental Examination prescribed by the erstwhile Hyderabad Government, should pass the Account Test for Public Works Department Officers and Subordinates, within the period of two years from the date of issue of the rules, subject to the condition that non-passing of the test within the prescribed period shall not be a bar for their promotion to higher categories.

Provided further that such of those Engineers as have attained the age of 45 years on the date of issue of the said rules shall be exempted from passing the said Account Test.

11. Conveyance Allowance:- There shall be paid to the members of the service conveyance allowance at such rates and subject to such conditions as may be determined by the Government from time to time.

12. Savings:- Notwithstanding anything contained in these rules or in the General Rules, all the temporary appointments made to the Category of Deputy Executive Engineers prior to the commencement of these rules, namely, the 2nd December, 1960 shall for the purpose of regularisation of the said temporary appointments be governed by the rules which were in force before such commencement.

13. Notwithstanding anything contained in the rules issued in G.O.Ms.No. 717, M.A., dated 8th July, 1964 as amended subsequently, all temporary appointments made to the category of Assistant Executive Engineers prior to the commencement of these rules shall be governed by these rules for all purposes.
